play any club with little chance of detection, the dancing of Fred Rense, Chris Gonzalez, an Alvin Renard, the eccentric lounge oldtimers Gita Gilman and Art West, and the impressions and droll humor of T. C. Jones.

Jones is a master of pace and mimicry. His take-offs of Katherine Hepburn, Bette Davis and others, and the excellence of his delayed or rising inflection climactic lines would make him a tonotch artist in any medium. If you think this a ridiculous rave then pop around to the Jewel Box and see for yourself.

DANNY BROWN, who with Doc Brenner dictates the destinies of the Jewel Box, would like some designation other than "female impersonators" for the performers who compose the cast of 85 in his 1952 Revue at the Jewel Box.

And, after watching his current artistic revue—and bearing in mind many a public performance which we've seen billed under the same female impersonation classification—we can well understand his eagerness to disassociate his troupe from the label.

The Jewel Box revue isn't just an excuse to allow a man who gets a biological kick out of strutting around in women's clothing and smearing make-up over his face to ply his trade in a loose manner of speaking.

We know none of the Jewel Box performers, except across the footlights, and so cannot vouch for the absence or presence of any possible psychological reason for their masquerading, but we do know that every one of the principals in the show exhibits a definite talent for the dancing, singing or comedy which he offers as his forte.

'Femimics' Impressive

BROWN'S STAGING of intricate production numbers, with choreography by Nat Danq, is in good taste, and the costumes by Bobby Bell are imaginative and eye-pleasing in the ultra-violet lighting which features two of them.

Jackie Maye, dripping with diamonds, lace and furs, headlines the bill and although he tosses a few lines which are concerned with the practice of boys being girls, between his vocal offerings, their content is no stronger than are such lines in the conventional cafes.

In the supporting specialties are the singing of Tod Allen and Laverne Cummings, the latter so effective in dress and so lyrically clear of voice that he could

Mickey Mercer, the only legitimate girl (if that is the proper phrase) in the cast, handles the emcee spot beautifully and then takes over, wearing a man's dinner suit, properly enough, for a finale song stint. Jerry Mann handles the musical chores.

We've tried to help Brown in whipping up a substitute for "female impersonator." Best we could do was "Femimics" or "Distaff Delineators" and we know neither of them would go too well in lights.

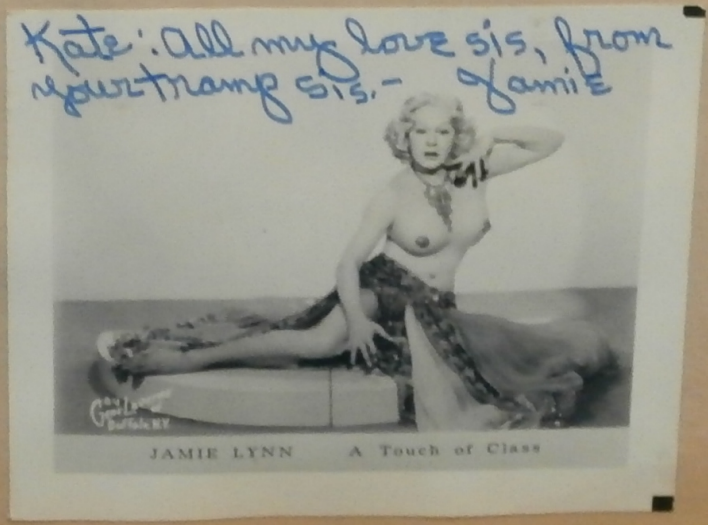

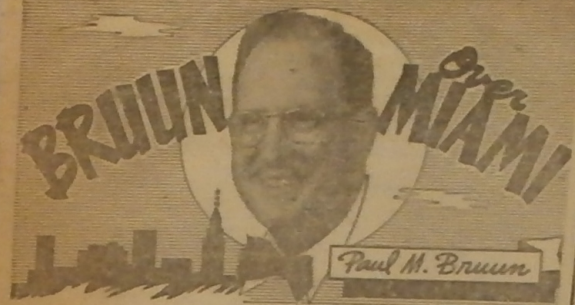

It is a good thing that I left my six-shooters at home or I would have pulled a dead aim on the character I think is Bobbie Bell for the murderous singing job he did on my favorite song, "Stormy Weather." I went home and played a couple of my records on it softly, so as not to awaken the family. I just couldn't go to sleep ever again remembering the gruesome murder of my show.

Jackie Small has been held over in this show. Jackie has one of the GOOD VOICES in this part of the world. From here on in will the management of Tony Pastor's please assign "Stormy Weather" to Small.

As I reported, the club was packed. If this business continues, there can be little doubt but that GAY shows will become the practice in Miami Beach. To the everlasting afflictment of the after-dark-loving trade, they seem to prefer these spectacles to standard talent.

Nobody loves a good joke or story better than I. Even when they have several meanings with something left to the imagination, I can lead the laugh parade. But I like something left to the imagination.

Several of the costumes at Tony Pastor's are really outstanding in spite of imitations wardrobe problems. Informally in the row at the Collins Ave. club and the minimum is two drinks. And you know something, I, a teetotaler all my life almost fell off the wagon. The temptation to consume some something good was so

Impersonators Fined For 'Mingling'

Six female impersonators were seized in an early-morning raid at Tony Pastor's night club today by Miami Beach police, following orders to crack down on clubs which allow impersonators to mingle with patrons.

All six, arrested a half-hour after their show had concluded, were fined \$10 and costs later by Municipal Judge Albert Saperstein.

The judge, in pronouncing sentence for the defendants, said "The community that permits this sort of thing is far more guilty than these people before me."

Fined were Richard Flood, 22, Billy Lee, 28, David Brennan, 28, and Corwin Greenwald, 27, of 738 Washington ave.; Theodore Bandis, 23, of 928 Fifth st., and James A. Bigood, 22, of 349 Ocean dr.

They were taken into custody when police raided the club at 2:30 a.m. Detectives Bill Murray, V. G. Miller, Sam Frederick, and Henry Dworkin, and Officers Bill Minor and Fred Biset participated.

At the trial in City court, Judge Saperstein stated "I can't stop these activities — because under the law they're technically legal — but I can sure limit them."

Police said the impersonators are required to go offstage and change into proper attire before they can legally mingle with patrons. The detectives testified that the six defendants were scattered among customers at the bar when they raided the club.

The entertainers told Judge Saperstein that they were not under orders from the management to mingle with patrons. "Nothing was ever said one way or another," one said.

Following the trial, Captain C. W. Pierce announced that a close watch would be kept on clubs in the city with similar shows "to make sure impersonators keep away from the public after the shows are over."

Six 'Ladies' Arrested

Impersonators Can't Mingle With Customers At Bars

It's not illegal to be a female impersonator—but don't mingle with the customers at the bar.

That order went out from Miami Beach police Wednesday and they backed it up with the arrest of six of the "ladies" in the show at Tony Pastor's.

A six-man squad swooped into the Ocean dr. nitery and whisked out six elaborately costumed and coiffed entertainers whom they found at the bar.

Fined \$10 and costs each in court were Richard Flood, Billy Lee, 28, David Brown, 25, Corwin Greenwald, 27, 208 Washington ave. and Lore Benda, 20, of 828 Fifth

st. and James A. Bridgood, 22, of 249 Ocean dr.

They were charged with "being in a dress not becoming to their sex."

Said Judge Albert Saperstein as he passed sentence:

"I can't stop these activities because under the law, they're technically legal. But I can sure limit them."

Some of the entertainers appeared to feel hurt over the charge that their dress was not "becoming."

"Well, I never," shorted Benda.

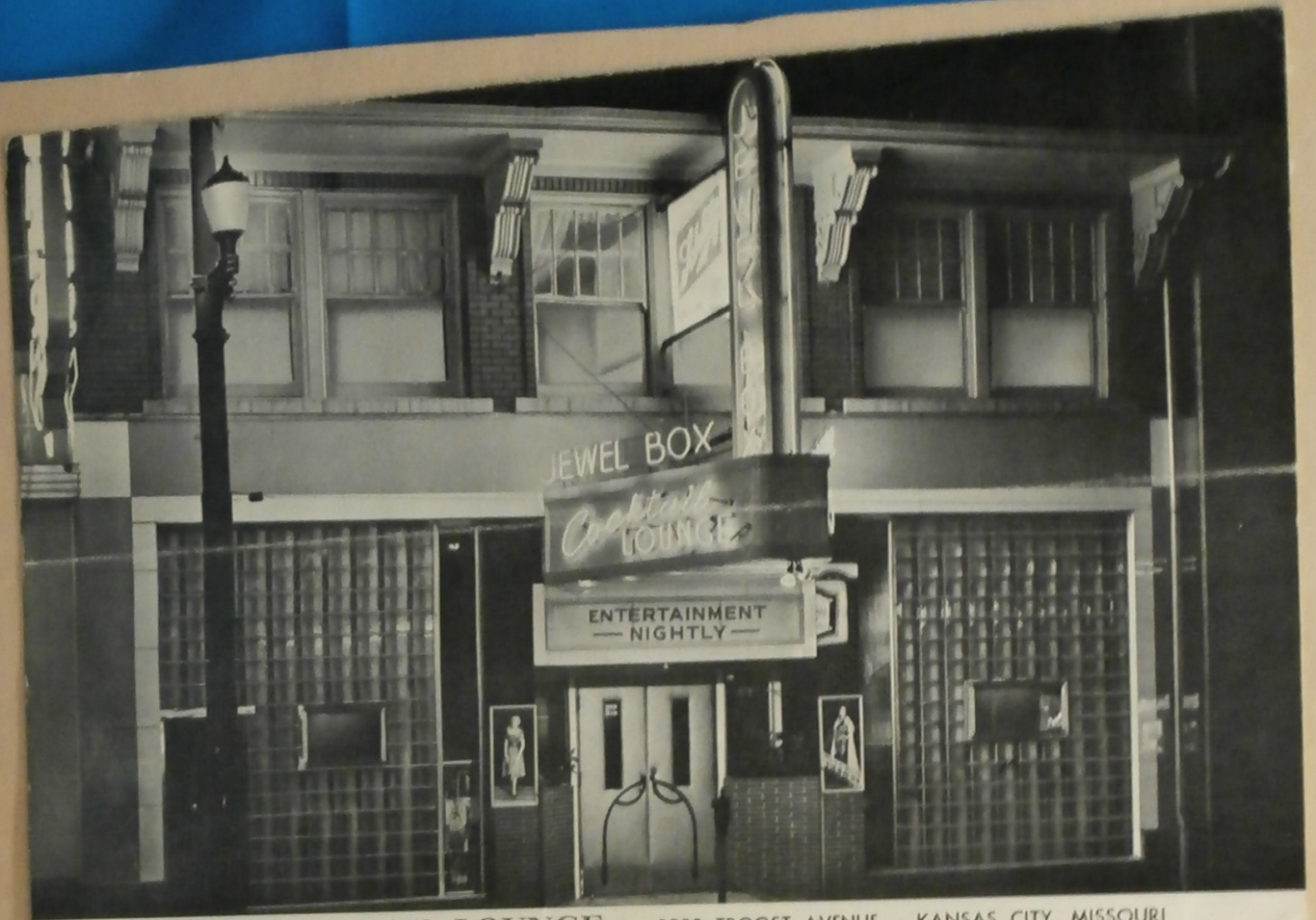

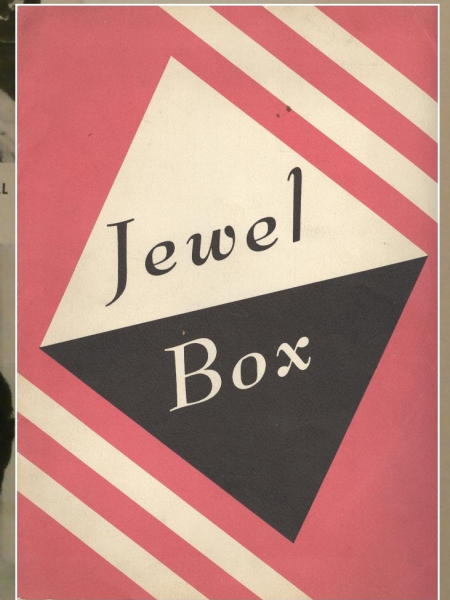
